GENEVA -Alice V. Kerr Marlow, 93, of Geneva N.Y., passed away on Wednesday, February 25, 2015 after a short illness.

She was a member of Trinity Church and enjoyed attending the Presbyterian Church in later years. She was a long time member of the Geneva Country Club, the American Legion, and Geneva Women's Club.

Alice was well known throughout the Geneva community and had many close friends. She loved to socialize and could often be found playing cards and having cocktails with her girlfriends at the Geneva Country Club or the American Legion.

Alice is survived by her three sons: Jim Marlow (Mike Bucar) of Rochester, Dr. John Marlow (Mary Ann) of Richmond, MN, Robert Marlow (Kelly) of Mount Kisco NY, and daughter Debbie Gallina (Charles) of Merrick NY; her sisters Barbara Pierce of Manhasset NY and Patricia Bucklin of Geneva NY. She had eight grandchildren, Jim and Alison Gallina, Jessica, Sarah, Matthew and Michael Marlow, and RJ and Will Marlow and several nieces and nephews.

She was predeceased by her loving husband Bill and her brother Winston Kerr.
