GENEVA – Daniel Bernard Powers passed away on Thursday, May 21, 2020 after a brief illness of cancer.

There will be no prior calling hours.

Due to the social distancing guidelines, a Mass of Christian Burial will be announced at a later date in St. Stephen's Church.

Dan was born on December 12, 1943 to Stanley and Mary Nolan Powers, in Geneva, New York. He graduated from De Sales High School, Class of 1961. Upon graduation, he started working at the American Can Co. and after the plant closed he started a new career at Wayne Finger Lakes BOCES and retired in 2016 as Head Custodian in Newark.

In 1963, he married Barbara Skinner and they enjoyed many beautiful family moments and memories. Dan was a life member of the Nester Hose Co. of the Geneva Fire Department, where he served as recording secretary for 7 years. Dan was an avid New York Yankees and New York Giants fan. Most recently, he and Barbara traveled by car to visit family and friends in Florida and Colorado. He enjoyed biking, golfing, and his 21 years living in Hall, NY. He also coached the fireman's Babe Ruth team.
